

My human development journey - presentation

Label the following stages along the timeline:

- **Baby** (0-1 years)
 - **Toddler** (1-3 years)
 - **Child** (2-12 years)
 - **Teenager** (13-19 years)
 - **Adult** (20-64 years)
 - **Older adult** - (64+)
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- Write 2 sentences about what happens during each stage.
 - Find out one interesting fact about each stage.
 - Draw or find pictures for each stage to illustrate what people might look like and what they do at that stage.
 - Add a photo or drawing of yourself and mark where you are on the timeline.
 - Write a short paragraph about what you enjoy doing at your current stage (child).
 - Ask an adult in your family about what they remember from their stages of development. Write down their answers and compare them to your own experiences.
 - Think about what you'd like to do in the future. What do you imagine life might be like when you're a teenager, an adult, or elderly? Add these thoughts to the timeline with speech or thought bubbles.

human gestation

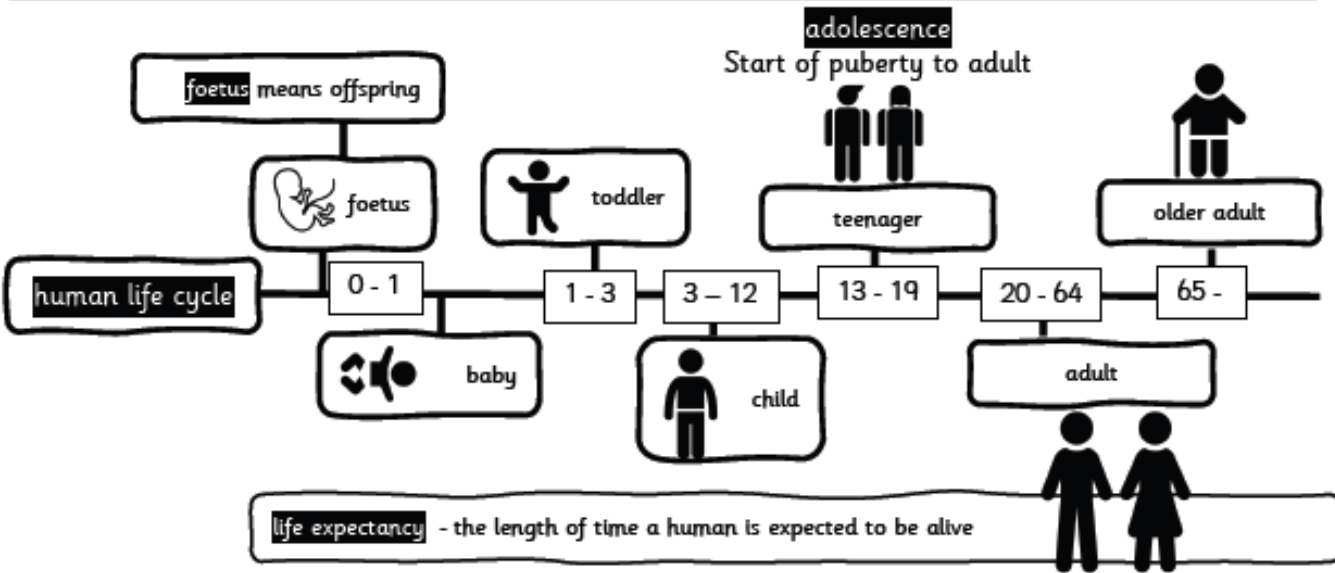


gestation is the growth and development of a baby before it is born

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embryo 0 - 7 weeks

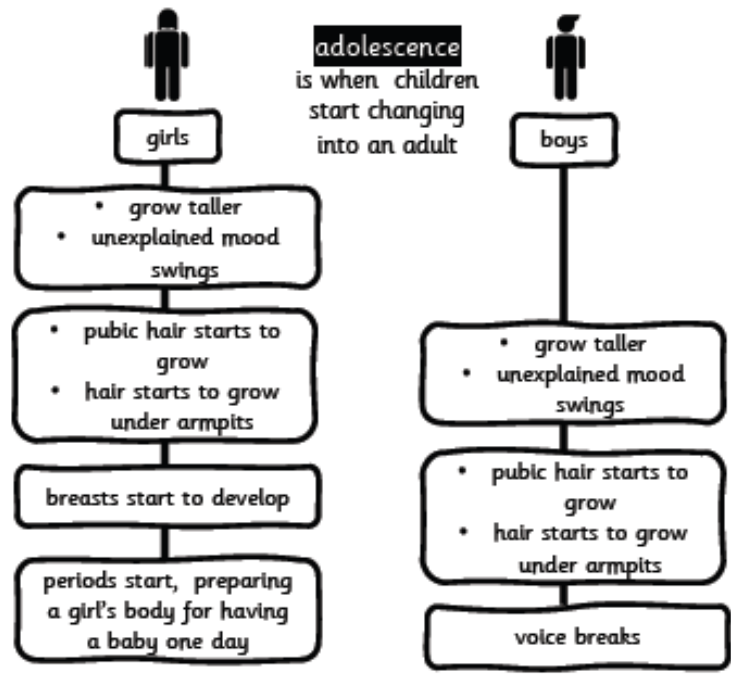
foetus - the name of an unborn baby from 8 - 40 weeks that grows in the womb
