A scaled score below 100 means that your child has not met the expected standards for the end of KS2 in this test.

A scaled score of 100 - 109 means that your child has met the expected standards for the end of KS2 in this test.

A scaled score of 110+ means that your child has exceeded the expected standards for the end of KS2 in this test.

The lowest scaled score that can be awarded is 80 and the highest scaled score is 120.

The assessment gradings on your child's end of year progress report are a judgement based on evidence throughout the whole school year, whereas the SATs assessment gradings are based on the SATs tests only.
