Dear parents,

We have had a number of emails recently from members of the public regarding road safety incidents around school. One member of the public has described having a couple of near misses with children, that have run out into the road without looking. Another hazard is when families are trying to cross between parked cars, where visibility is poor.

As you are aware, the Bradford Road Safety team have recently been in school and the children were taught all about crossing the road safely, where it is safe to cross and the potential dangers of crossing the road.

In addition to this, we will be having a 'Road Safety' assembly in school, where we will be covering the importance of being safe when crossing the road.

The road outside school is extremely busy, please could we ask parents to reinforce road safety and to help us by always using the crossing if you need to cross. We appreciate that the crossing gets busy, however, a couple of extra seconds/minutes waiting to cross, could save a life.

If your child walks home without an adult, please have a discussion with them about using the importance of using the crossing.
